As you can see on the attachment, your family has been selected to help with basketball concessions.

- **Families are required to work one shift for the evening, everyone works 5:30 p.m. to close.**
- Those families with **more than one student** in Fine Arts may be asked to work twice.
- **Elementary** students may not work. Students in junior and senior high can work.
- **One parent must work from each family as well as the student. If the student has duties during the work time, then both parents must work.**
- **What does that mean for our family? One parent, as in Michele or Stevelarson , and a student. Or, both Michele and Steve, but no student.**

We are also planning ahead in the event our students are blessed with a place in postseason play. If you are on the postseason schedule someone will be confirming with you as we have scheduled all of the possible games, we may not host all of those games.
